Required permissions - long term buy to let and bridging buy to let advised sale	
Channel	Permissions required
Directly Authorised	Categories C (Credit Broking) and (where there is any element of debt consolidation) E (Debt Counselling)
Mortgage Club/ Packager	None - on the basis that the Mortgage Club does not have any interaction with the customer and the 'club member' (a duly authorised broker) will submit the case direct to Precise Mortgages
Network does not have full FCA authorisation for 'regulated credit agreements'	
Appointed Representatives	Categories C (Credit Broking) and (where there is any element of debt consolidation) E (Debt Counselling)
Network	Category C (Credit Broking)
Network has full FCA authorisation for 'regulated credit agreements'
